一、宗旨

中華佛學研究所為教育部立案之研究機構，專注於漢傳佛教的學術研究與出版工作。本所創辦人聖嚴法師提出「立足中華，放眼世界」的指導方針，作為推動研究的核心理念。為促進國內外漢傳佛教學術之交流與發展，本所特舉辦徵文活動，並收錄出版《中華佛學研究》期刊，以鼓勵學者及碩、博士研究生投入漢傳佛教相關課題之探討。

二、徵文主題

凡與「漢傳佛教」有關之文、史、哲、藝術、心理、教育等各個層面之學術性論文，均為本期刊所歡迎。

三、徵稿對象

1. 海內外大專院校及研究機構之學者，或具博士學位者。
2. 博士班及碩士班研究生（依本所獎勵辦法辦理）

四、截稿時間

截稿日期為每年七月三十日，逾期稿件將列入次期處理。若遇特殊情況，經編審委員會核准後，得予以調整。所有來稿均須送交審查，審查通過者將刊登於每年十二月出版之《中華佛學研究》期刊。

五、獎勵辦法

- 博士班研究生每篇新台幣二萬元（含稅）。
- 碩士班研究生每篇新台幣一萬元（含稅）。

六、報名方式

1. 繳交「投稿資料表」、「著作授權同意書」。

2. 繳交文稿電子檔(含 DOC 檔與 PDF 檔)及特殊字型檔、圖檔。
3. 繳交在學證明書電子檔。
4. 繳交一位教授推薦信,內容須包含對投稿文章之評語。

七、執行方式

1. 來稿請以中文、日文或英文撰寫為主。中文稿件字數以 10,000 至 20,000 字為宜(含註腳、摘要及引用文獻)。完整稿件須包含以下內容: 題目、約 300-500 字之摘要、3 至 5 個關鍵詞,並附目次及參考書目(引用文獻)。論文註釋請採隨頁註。詳細「撰寫格式」請參照《中華佛學研究》之撰稿規範(可至 <http://www.chibs.edu.tw> 下載)。
2. 本刊採雙匿名教授審查。依據審查委員之意見,保有決議是否刊登之權力。作者對審查意見不同意修正,則視為自行撤回稿件。
3. 本刊有文字及版面格式修改之權利。二校請作者自校,文字請勿作過多刪補,以免造成編輯困難。
4. 本刊不接受一稿數投,文責由作者自負。來稿經採用後,版權即屬本刊所有,以紙本或數位方式出版,並授權本所於所屬之網路資料庫或光碟流通。未經本所編審委員會同意,不得在他處發表或另行出版。

Call for Papers: *Chung-Hwa Buddhist Studies*

The Chung-Hwa Institute of Buddhist Studies, an accredited research institute dedicated to academic research and publication in Chinese Buddhism, has launched a grant project for graduate students. In line with the institute motto declared by founder Master Sheng Yen, “Our roots are Chinese; and branches are global,” the Chung-Hwa Institute of Buddhist Studies and the Sheng Yen Education Foundation cooperate to offer with opportunities of publication and financial supports via the journal, *Chung-Hwa Buddhist Studies*.

I. Topics of contribution

Academic articles related to Chinese Buddhism of any period within a wide variety of fields, e.g., literature, history, philosophy, art, psychology, education, etc., are welcome.

II. Prospective contributors

Students currently enrolled in domestic and international graduate programs are welcome to submit their academic works. Prospectives with a Master’s degree who are considering further study are invited as well.

III. Deadline

An issue deadline is set on July 30th annually. Manuscripts received after July 30th will be considered for the next issue except for special occasions recognized by the editorial committee. Manuscripts received by the deadline will be reviewed for the issue published in December annually.

IV. Contribution Fee

Accepted articles from students in M.A. programs or contributors with a Master’s degree will be awarded NT\$10,000 (approximately 300 USD) .

Ph.D. students whose article gets accepted will receive NT\$20,000 (approximately 600 USD).

*This project will be offered continuously until further announcement. (Twenty percent tax will be deducted.)

V. Submission checklist

1. A “Contributor’s Information Sheet” and “Copyright License Agreement” (These forms are available online at <http://www.chibs.edu.tw>)
2. A validated statement of enrollment in graduate program, or a copy of the Master’s degree diploma.
3. Digital versions of the article (both DOC and PDF files), along with font files for special characters and/or image files (if applicable)
4. A recommendation letter from the academic adviser. Comments on the article submitted must be included in the recommendation letter as well. And the recommendation letter should be submitted directly to the following address from the academic adviser.

VI. Submission guidelines

1. Manuscripts are expected in Chinese, English, or Japanese, with a length of 10,000 to 20,000 words. A complete manuscript should include the following components: the title, an abstract within 500 words, and five keywords in both English and Chinese (or Japanese), along with table of contents and references. Please see “manuscript formatting” for the suggested format of manuscripts (available at <http://www.chibs.edu.tw>).
2. All submissions will be reviewed anonymously by two outside reviewers. Acceptance of submitted manuscripts will be based solely upon the opinions of the reviewers. Authors unwilling to meet reviewers’ suggestion for revision will be considered as withdrawal of the submission.
3. *Chung-Hwa Buddhist Studies* reserves the right to revise articles. The author is responsible for proofreading before publication.
4. Authors submitting a manuscript to the *Chung-Hwa Buddhist Studies* should not

simultaneously submit the manuscript to another journal. And the author should take full liability for the submitted article. Copyright of all accepted works will transfer to the *Chung-Hwa Buddhist Studies*. CHIBS may include articles in on-line databases or CD/DVD titles for academic distribution. The authors will be provided two copies of the published *Chung-Hwa Buddhist Studies*. Written permission must be obtained in advance to reprint or reproduce articles.
